This is the application if you would like to be considered for one of the award-winning Pattonville media staffs for the 2013-2014 school year. Staff member requirements: Staff members are required to work well with others on group projects. You must have excellent writing and technology skills. Journalism involves many deadlines, some of which require work done outside of the normal class period, so attendance, a strong work ethic and a willingness to stay after school are all important qualifications of staff members.

If you feel you would make a good addition to the online, newspaper or yearbook staff, please complete the attached application form. You must have three teachers fill out the teacher recommendation forms. One must be your current English teacher, but all three need to be your teachers during the 2012-2013 school year. You need to deliver these forms to your teachers, but your teachers must return them to Mr. Heyman.

Please turn in your application on or before **Friday, January 11, 2013.** If you are not currently enrolled in a journalism class or publications staff, you should submit your application to Mr. Heyman in B108/B110 or place in his teacher's mailbox.

<u>No late applications will be accepted.</u> If applicants are unable to meet this deadline, the adviser will assume they will not be able to meet deadlines that occur during the production of the website, newspaper or yearbook and will reject the application.

Interviews will be held Jan. 14-17, 2013, and you will be notified before Stop Day on Jan. 22, 2013, as to whether or not you have been selected for a media staff.
